## ACCORDIAN FLOWER TUTORIAL



### MATERIALS NEEDED:

Pretty in Pink 12x12 (106546)  
Real Red (102482)  
Very Vanilla (101650)  
Sending Love DSP (117153) from Occasions Mini 2010  
Boho Blossoms Punch (110711)  
Trio Flower Punch (109183)  
1 ¼ circle punch (104403)  
Tombow Glue (110755)

### MAKING THE FLOWERS:

To make four paper flowers cut DSP to 1 ¼ x 10, 1 x 10, ¾ x 10, and another one 1 x 10.  
Fold DSP like an accordion

Here's one I started at 1" x 9"  
Fold it accordion style all the way till end.

If you look at both ends of the accordion, both ends should be facing up.

Take both ends facing up and staple them together

To know which side is going to be shown on the top side or front is the inside of that accordion that you stapled.

Make sure that both ends are ending up on the accordion fold.



Staple both ends together.



You have to now spread it sort of pushing the inside toward you to flatten flower out.



Cut 1 ¼ circle and glue it to the side of flower you don't want shown with Tombow glue



I use a clamp to hold it together for a few minutes.  
Here's the back with the circle



Here's the front of the flower



Decorate flower with the punches I've listed above or brads, buttons or ribbon.
