

## Christening Gown

### Step 1 – cutting neckline of dress



Cut your card-stock to  $4\frac{1}{4}$  x 11 . Fold at center at  $5\frac{1}{2}$  to make  $4\frac{1}{4}$  x  $5\frac{1}{4}$  card

Using  $1\frac{3}{8}$  circle punch by SU! punch a  $\frac{1}{2}$  circle in top fold.

### Step 2 – cutting sleeves of dress



Holding the card horizontally (fold to the left) Place fold at  $1\frac{3}{4}$  mark on left side of cutter. Cut down a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch and stop. This makes the sleeves.

Do that on both sides.

### Step 3 – cutting length of dress



Place bottom of dress at the groove at the top of cutter where you slide your cutter, and then place top of dress at the 1 inch mark on the left side of cutter groove on the lower end of cutter. Cut up to the  $\frac{1}{2}$  mark you made for the sleeve. Flip and do same to other side.

This is what it should look like:



## Step 4

Emboss using the Dots embossing folder and Big Shot (113439) from Stampin' Up!

Take the Stampin' Up! Eyelet border punch (113692) to the bottom of the dress.

Embellish as you'd like. I used ribbon and pearls.

Here's how mine turned out.
