

Halloween Treat Bag Tutorial – All items are through Stampin' Up! Unless noted



Materials needed:

Stampin' Up!'s Whisper White square envelopes (107309)

Mini favor bags from local party supply store. The bags are 3 x 5. Just cut down the 5 inches to 3 inches.

Punches: Scallop Circle Punch (109043)
1 ¼ Circle Punch (104403)
Word Window Punch (105090)
Large Oval Punch (107305)

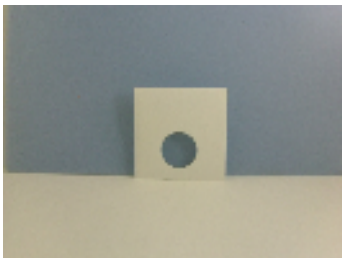
Inks: Basic Black (101179)
Pumpkin Pie (105216)

Ribbon: ½ Striped Pumpkin Pie (110715)

Crop-A-Dile (108362)

Stamp Set: Itty Bitty Backgrounds (114996)
Teeny Tiny Wishes (115370)

DIRECTIONS:



Cut 1 ¼ Circle Punch through envelope making sure you leave enough room for ribbon at top and not cutting into the flap of envelope



To create the two scalloped circles first punch in Pumpkin Pie using the 1 ¼ inch circle and then position Scallop Circle punch over the 1 ¼ circle

Stamp with Black and Pumpkin Pie ink with Itty Bitty Backgrounds to front and back of envelope, including flap. Flap will probably have to be cut as it could overlap window in envelope.



Apply scalloped circles to front and back of envelope.

Cut party favor bag down to 3 x 3 and insert into envelope. It fits perfectly. Fill with Candy Corn and seal.

Punch two holes in top of envelope for striped ribbon

Punch out “Happy Halloween” with Pumpkin Pie ink from the Teeny Tiny Wishes with Word Window punch. Attach to Large Oval punched in Pumpkin Pie. Use small hole on Crop-A-Dile and punch Large Oval once to attach tag to striped ribbon with some thread or however you see fit.

Use large punch hole from Crop-A-Dile and punch two holes for the striped ribbon at top of envelope. I set the depth to ½ inch. Thread Striped ribbon through. Attach Oval tag to striped ribbon and you're done.
